<b>Junior Show General</b>	Page
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New age requirements will go into effect for the 2023 show</li> <li>• Overall Grand and Reserve Champion Market Animals become the property of the Arizona National immediately after selection and will be harvested</li> <li>• There will not be an auction for junior market animals</li> <li>• Increased premiums for Grand Champion, Reserve Champion and 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> overall market animals</li> </ul>	65 67  See division rules
<b>Open Cattle</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open Cattle exhibitors will be required to purchase Early Bird Load In passes to arrive and unload on December 26</li> </ul>	
<b>Junior Cattle</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There will not be a progress steer show, all steers weighing 1000 lbs. and more will be entered in the Market Steer show, DNA samples will be required</li> </ul>	
<b>Junior Sheep</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Market Lambs will be shown by color/breed</li> <li>• Tooth rule has been eliminated</li> </ul>	88
<b>Junior Goat</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No stimulants allowed to cause tail to be erect</li> <li>• Tooth rule has been eliminated</li> </ul>	96

## 2022 Summary of Policy Changes

<b>Fire Marshall Regulations</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All generators and propane heaters will be placed within established areas. Significant fines and/or confiscation by the Fire Marshall may be imposed on violators.</li> <li>• All portable tents will be set up within established boundaries, no propane heaters will be allowed inside of tents.</li> </ul>
