No dual entry	Exhibitor may not enter one animal in more than one division, e.g. junior heifer cannot be entered in prospect cattle and a steer cannot be entered into both Market and Prospect (exception #1: A heifer may be entered in both the Junior Heifer and Open Cattle Departments; #2: All Arizona animals will be automatically entered in their respective Best Arizona Department(s); #3: If a Prospect steer weighs more than 999, and has an valid DNA kit on file, it may be moved to the Market Steer Division; #4: If a Market steer weighs less than 1000 lbs, it may be moved to the Prospect Cattle Division). 4.	Champion and reserve selection	Only first and second place animals in each class are eligible for division/breed champion and reserve awards.	General	12, #45

8.	Dogs allowed	Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Dogs that show aggression must be removed from the grounds immediately. Animal Control will be contacted if necessary. Dog waste must be picked up.	General	14, #71
9.	No unhooking in staging lot	Vehicles may not unhook from trailers in the staging lots. (DPS lot and West lot)	General	14, #75
10.	Rose Mofford award	Once an exhibitor has been awarded the Rose Mofford Award they are not eligible to apply again.	Junior Show	67

11.	Penning	Sheep, goat and swine exhibitors are encouraged to bring pen dividers. Sheep and goats will be stalled three per pen, swine will be stalled two per pen.	Junior Show	70, #35
12.	Consign to packer animals to holding pens	Exhibitors consigning market animals to packer will be required to deliver animal to packer holding pen/area between 10:00 a.m. and noon on December 31 (unless animal is being used in livestock judging contest)	Junior Show	71, #47
13.	Move market steer entry to prospect cattle if weigh less than 1000 lbs.	Underweight market steers may move to the Prospect Cattle Division	Jr Cattle	85, #6
14.	Prospect Cattle weighing more than 999 lbs.	Exhibitors may submit a DNA kit on prospect steers if there is a concern that the steer will weigh more 999 lbs. at weigh in. 18.	Market steer classification – re-classing clarification	Market Steer exhibitors will declare steer's color/breed division at the time of entry. Each Market steer (other than those declared as AOC) will be presented for classification to a three-person committee (time and location to be announced). 20.	No paint on swine	If a pig is found with paint or other unapproved products, the exhibitor may remove the animal from the holding pen, take it to the wash rack to clean it, and return. 22.	Livestock Judging require \$100 refundable deposit	A \$100 refundable deposit (or valid PO) per team. \$25 refundable deposit (or valid PO) per additional individual. Fee must be included with entry. Fee will be refunded for teams/individuals that enter and compete in the Junior Livestock Judging Contest.
